Point System Rules for NSF Invitations:

The following items will be used to decide placements for the qualification to the NSF.

- 1. There will be 3 qualifying events. Any angler is allowed to fish all qualifiers associated to the year.
- 2. Each participant's final position in their respective division (Boater / Co-angler) shall be based on the cumulative total of their 2 best qualifier finishes.
- 3. Points for each qualifier tournament shall be assigned as follows:
 - a. Tournament winner (heaviest weight) will receive 100 points and then reduce by 1 point for each position thereafter.
 - b. Any participating angler that fishes a tournament and "blanks" shall receive 25 points.
- 4. All year end point ties will be decided by the following sequence:
 - a. Total number of fish caught in tournaments.
 - b. Highest finish position in a single tournament.
 - c. Largest single day stringer weight.
 - d. Coin flip.
